Dear Members & Friends of Immanuel:

July is a time of celebrations. Especially this year with our nation's 250th birthday. It does not seem that long ago we Americans were preparing to celebrate our country's bicentennial.

During the summer of 1976, I was living on the West Bank at the University of Minnesota, working full-time weekdays at the Prudential Insurance home office in Office Services and in the Mail Department on Saturdays. I was coaching my father's church softball team in northwest Minneapolis and was one of the youth group leaders of his church, taking the kids on trips to the Apple River in Wisconsin and the St. Croix River that separates the two states. Not thinking of pastoral ministry at that point, the Lord was preparing me for something ahead that I could not see – a lifetime at Immanuel Lutheran in Alpena, Michigan. Looking back, I really didn't know much about life. But I did know the words of "*Philadelphia Freedom*", sung by Elton John for America's 200th birthday. In August, I drove a friend of mine from Free Lutheran Bible College out to Vancouver, British Columbia, to begin his studies in Seminary. I had no idea two years later I would begin Seminary studies myself in St. Louis, Missouri. It was not on my radar screen at all.

But it was on the Lord's radar. I realize now the invisible hand of God, that providential hand, was carefully guiding my life to Alpena. The past couple of months, together with Lisa, I have been pouring over the avalanche of cards, letters and notes, incredibly generous gifts, beautifully hand-drawn pictures and well-wishes from the precious children of our Lutheran School received at my retirement celebration on May 1st. There were so many memories and recollections over the past 44 years. It is only in the past couple of weeks that Lisa and I finally made it through the baskets given to me that evening. How humbling that the Lord could use this struggling preacher's kid to be, of all things, a pastor. From the day I was ordained in August 1982 I have never second-guessed God's call to pastoral ministry.

Full-time rostered status here at Immanuel ends on July 1st. I have offered to serve this gracious congregation as Vacancy Pastor for the time being as we continue to wait on the Lord for a new Senior Pastor. Nothing much is changing in pastoral coverage except for a slightly reduced workload and part-time wage. Pastor Schultz and Deacon Wolf will continue to help out as they have been doing over the past year since the call process began in the spring of 2025.

Celebration is in order for our school expansion project. Having reached our \$450,000 match and surpassing the \$2,000,000 threshold, the vision of expanding our school's ministry into grades 9 & 10 is becoming a reality next month. A special dedication service at the Pinecrest property has been scheduled for Sunday, August 23 @ 4:00 p.m. Only the Lord could move hearts and hands to work in unity toward this daunting, yet exciting, expansion into a two-campus school.

As we celebrate America's 250 years of liberty and freedom, may we look up with thanksgiving to our God who called us out of the darkness of sin and death into the marvelous light of the Savior. That freedom of living in Christ Jesus, the author and completer of our faith, endures forever!

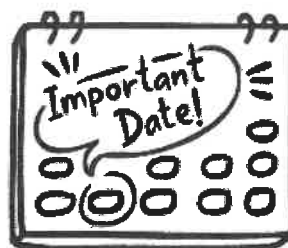

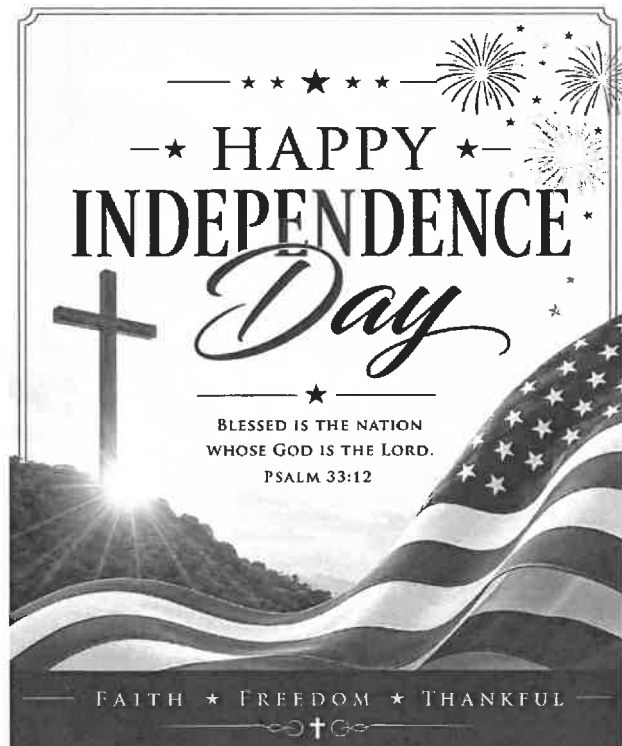
